

EtonHouse to open an International School in Dalian, China

January, 2011 – EtonHouse becomes the first Singaporean organization to start an International School in Dalian, an economic hub in North-east China. The school is being developed in collaboration with the Shui On Group, a renowned property developer in Hong Kong and mainland China.

Dalian has an excellent geographical location and serves as an important marine gateway connecting northeast China and North China to the whole world. Dalian's proximity to Japan, Korea and Russia offers immense economic advantages to it. EtonHouse was invited by the Dalian government to open an International School offering programmes in the early childhood, primary and secondary levels (K-12). The school will be a located in 'Dalian Tiandi', an integrated mix-use development set in the scenic city of Dalian, located in China's northeast Liaoning Province. The Dalian Tiandi concept developed by the Shui On Group provides a green, highly modern, trendsetting way of living designed to attract intellectuals from across the IT industry. The Shui On Group is renowned for having developed property in Shanghai's upmarket Xin Tien Di district.

EtonHouse in Dalian will be a purpose-built school spread across 12,500 square meters with residential facilities and state-of-the-art educational and outdoor resources such as heated indoor swimming pools, spacious library facilities, IT labs, gymnasium and extensive outdoor and indoor sports areas etc. The school will be offering its internationally acclaimed inquiry based early childhood curriculum and IB framework for the primary, middle and diploma levels. The teaching staff will be a mix of international and local professionals in the education sector.

Catering to 600 children from 3 to 16 years of age, the EtonHouse International School in Dalian will attract and cater to expatriates in Dalian and international students seeking high quality international education. It will also enhance and attract more foreign investment to the region

The programme equips children with strong language skills. The Pre-Sap Bilingual Mandarin programme (operating in Singapore) and the integrated Mandarin programme offers children a natural and inclusive environment to develop strong language skills.
