

## A bilingual international education for the first time in Singapore

**April 2011, Singapore,** the EtonHouse International Education Group is launching two innovative programmes in Mandarin in April 2011 in response to a strong demand for bilingual education in Singapore.

The EtonHouse International School located on the East Coast is an International Baccalaureate World School offering pre-school and primary level education. It will, for the first time in Singapore, offer a truly integrated bilingual programme for primary students and a Mandarin early childhood programme for pre-schoolers.

The first programme starting in August 2011 will be open to expatriate families in Singapore for children who are 7 or turning 7 years in 2011. It will be offered in a dual language environment and will include one expatriate and one Mandarin speaking teacher in the classroom. This will offer a truly bilingual environment where students will respond better to Mandarin as it is offered in a natural and contextual environment. The timetable is organised to include key language focus blocks. One language is used for communication at a time, supported by explanations of core concepts in the second language, as needed. The inquiry based curriculum will follow that of the International Baccalaureate's Primary Years Programme (PYP) framework.

The school has already received expressions of interest and registrations from parents to enrol their children in this programme. The bilingual programme is being offered in response to parents who are keen that their children engage in Mandarin more meaningfully rather than just a second language as is offered in traditional international school settings. There has been increasing interest amongst parents from different nationalities and families who represent a mix of Asian and western cultures to offer their children an education that has a strong foundation in Mandarin.

The second programme will cater to pre-school children. The EtonHouse pre-school on Broadrick Road will also offer an EtonHouse Mandarin early childhood programme starting in May 2011 for parents of all nationalities including Singaporeans. This is in response to the strong demand amongst parents for their children to appreciate and love Mandarin at an early age and will cater to children from 1.5-6 years of age.

Research proves that the earlier children are exposed to a language, the better is the language acquisition process. The primary objective of this programme is to offer an early immersion programme in Mandarin that will engage young children and inculcate in them a love for the language. The programme will offer the EtonHouse inquiry based pre-school curriculum entirely in Mandarin for the Nursery levels. It will integrate highly acclaimed methodologies in Mandarin language learning having being developed by pedagogical experts who have several years of teaching and leadership experiences. In the Kindergarten levels, the curriculum will be offered in an integrated bilingual environment with both English and Mandarin being the medium of communication.

The EtonHouse Mandarin Pre-School will offer children a strong foundation in Mandarin in the early years that will enable children to be naturally responsive to the language and effectively read and write in Mandarin. The early years programme will be engaging and fun for the children in a high quality teaching and learning environment. The teaching staff will be native Chinese language teachers from China who have professional qualifications in early childhood.

EtonHouse offers an excellent second languages programme in Chinese, Japanese and Hindi. It also offers Pre-Sap, an innovative, in-depth and challenging programme for those proficient in the Mandarin language.

EtonHouse has over 16 years of experience in running pre-schools and international schools and has over 43 schools spread across Singapore, China, Indonesia, Korea, Japan, India, Malaysia and Vietnam. With over 3000 students from 54 different nationalities, the EtonHouse schools have a truly dynamic and multicultural environment with proven expertise in offering international educational environments of the highest standards.

EtonHouse Newton and Orchard are the first stand-alone pre-schools in Singapore to acquire the IB PYP World School status.

EtonHouse schools and pre-schools offer exceptional second language programmes viz. the Mandarin immersion programme and the Pre-SAP programme that equip children in strong second language skills.

EtonHouse also runs its in-house research and professional development centre - EtonHouse Education Centre (EEC). The EEC provides continuous training and pedagogical support. Recently the EEC brought the first Reggio Children conference to Singapore. It was well attended by educators from around the Asia region and demonstrated the EtonHouse commitment to best practice in the field of Early Childhood Education. One of the greatest strengths that EtonHouse has is the exceptional quality of its teaching staff.
