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EtonHouse launches The Eton Academy Enrichment and tuition for pre-school and primary students

The Eton Academy (TEA), part of the EtonHouse International Education Group, has opened its first centre in Canberra Plaza.

Backed by the internationally and locally recognised programmes in both pre-school, primary, and secondary offered in the EtonHouse and E-Bridge schools and pre-schools, TEA will be an independent arm focussing on enrichment and tuition for students from age four and above. At the time of launch, TEA will also be offering bursaries for one academic year to 25 students from disadvantaged backgrounds in the Sembawang GRC.

‘Setting curiosity in motion’ is how the TEA has created and developed its subject-specific curriculum and enrichment programmes. Children from 4 years and above can enrol for English, Maths and Science programmes that have been specifically curated to enable learners to acquire academic content while also nurturing confidence, competence, and a lifelong love for learning.

Teachers provoke curiosity in learners through a variety of teaching methods. In a kindergarten Mathematics class, children will be invited to learn about Usain Bolt and his record-breaking feats. Children will explore the mathematical concept of measurement by finding out how fast he ran, his height, and his strides' length. They can further explore the concept of time by looking into his training schedule and understanding the difference between a.m. and p.m.

In a typical English lesson, carefully curated children’s books will be used as a form of provocation, inviting children to enjoy the story as it unfolds and pay attention to the craft of writing and the use of vocabulary. Children are then encouraged to emulate these best writing practices in their own ways.

Even as children remain in Singapore and in their classrooms, with the help of immersive 3D technology, The Eton Academy brings the world straight to their students through a customised, immersive, and interactive learning space. The interactive modules serve as a form of provocation, with the teacher facilitating the students' inquiry into each theme. Students take the helm when exploring 3D environments, uncovering facts, and discovering tasks on their own!

Class sizes will be between 8-12 students, and fees will be between \$280-300 for four lessons. TEA will be offering trial lessons in addition to registration fee waivers and discounts off term fees as an inaugural offer for families. The TEA team has many years of experience in the enrichment and tuition

space and come equipped with the unique EtonHouse pedagogy of inculcating life long learners through exploration and inquiry. This disposition will lay the foundation for success in the present and the future.

In 2017, the EtonHouse Group launched Middleton International School (MIS), an affordable schooling option for expatriate families that now has a campus in Tampines with a capacity of more than 1000 students. In 2018, EtonHouse launched its first K12 campus in Singapore on Orchard road.
